The Importance of a Recare Visit

They are painless, quick, inexpensive and can be life saving.

Did you know that you should keep your dentures moist when you aren't wearing them? This will keep them from drying out and losing their shape. Store your dentures in a denture cleanser soaking solution or in water. Never place your dentures in hot water as this can cause them to warp and change its shape.
