When Should Someone Wear a Mouthguard?

Mouthguards should be worn by athletes as part of their safety equipment during sports activities that involve a risk of falls or head contact with other players or equipment. It helps aids in the prevention of concussions, brain trauma and multiple severe oral injuries.

We use Pro-Form Mouthguard Laminates which is a strong two layer material made of high energy absorbing EVA vinyl. The laminate is 0.160" thick and is available in many colours. It does not interfere with breathing, talking or drinking. The risk of injuries is lessened by about 90% when wearing a Pro-Form mouthguard. Pro-Form sports performance mouthguards are the only sports mouthguard endorsed by the NHL & NFL. Hockey and football are not the only sports that require mouthguards to be worn. Other sports activities such as; baseball, basketball soccer, skateboarding, snowboarding and even gymnastics also require mouth protection. We usually think of football and hockey as the most dangerous sports for teeth, but did you know that nearly half of sports related mouth injuries occur in basketball and baseball?

Each mouthguard is custom fitted for the individual wearing it. We must take an impression to get an exact fit of the person's mouth. No two mouthguards are the same. They are adapted to fit comfortably over the upper teeth. Mouthguards are important because the average cost of dental treatment over a lifetime for one tooth lost is approximately \$5000.00. When it comes to sports equipment, mouthguards are a priority. They protect not only the teeth, but the lips cheeks and tongue.



Mouthguard Care Tips

When not in use, all mouthguards should be stored in a plastic container to avoid damage due to excessive heat or cold. They should be washed after each use, using cold or lukewarm water. Hot water may cause distortion. Prior to insertion, a mouthguard may be rinsed in mouthwash to freshen the taste.

As a general rule, it is recommended that a standard mouthguard be replaced every two to three years.
