## Recipe

### HOMEMADE APPLE CIDER

- 1 orange
- 10 medium apple (use a variety-granny smith & honey crisp)
- 3 cinnamon sticks (or 1 tsp ground cinnamon)
- 2 tsp ground cloves
- 1 tbsp sugar (adjust to your taste)

Peel the orange and cut apples into quarters (removing core & seeds). Add remaining ingredients into a pot and enough water to cover the fruit. Simmer for 2 hrs. Mash the fruit and simmer for another hour. Slowly, strain the chunky liquid through a fine mesh sieve into a large pot or pitcher. Discard solids. Strain the cider again. Serve the cider warm or drink it cold. Will keep in refrigerator 5-7 days.

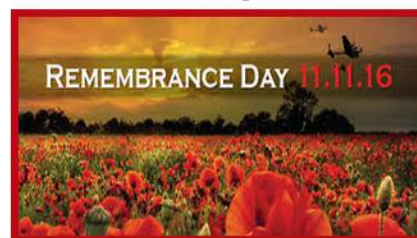

## Helpful Tips

To brighten and whiten your dentures book an appointment with us. We will professionally clean and sterilize your dentures in our on-site lab. We use pumice which will take off any tartar build up. Never use bleach or regular toothpaste to clean your dentures. Bleach will change the colour of the acrylic which will take away the natural look and toothpaste is very abrasive. This could contribute to the loss of lustre and beauty of the denture teeth and base. It is recommended that a denture cleaner be used at home and if you run out then use dish soap and water as a substitute.
