When to get a Reline after an Immediate Insert?

We all know that an Immediate Denture is to avoid the situation of being without teeth. This involves taking impressions of your mouth while your natural teeth are still present. A denture is then fabricated to the likeness of your natural teeth.

When your natural teeth are extracted, your Immediate Denture is then inserted. In this technique, you have avoided having to go without any teeth while you go through the year long healing process.

Things you should know about Immediate Dentures...

Since the denture cannot be tried in prior to extracting your teeth, certain aesthetic compromises may be necessary. As healing occurs, the oral tissues recede and the gums will shrink, thus adjustment appointments may be required. It is important to note that your denture does not change its shape. It will become loose due to shrinkage of your gums. To maintain the best fit and comfort a temporary liner or tissue conditioner may be placed in the denture. During the next few months, bone and gum tissue will probably continue to shrink to some degree; however the rate of change decreases with time. This is a natural occurrence, which is to be expected.

After the healing process is complete, which takes an average time of one year, then a reline or rebase will be required to ensure the most comfortable fit possible. At this appointment, we will remove any temporary liners that might have started peeling and take a new impression, so that we may have an exact fit of how your gums have changed. We will then reline (refit) the denture. This is an additional cost and usually takes one full day to do, as we have a full service denture lab on the premises.

Recipe



SENSATIONAL TRUFFLES

2 1/2 pkg. (225 g each) Baker semi-sweet chocolate divided 1 pkg (250 g) Philadelphia Brick Cream Cheese, softened



Melt 1 pkg chocolate as directed on pkg. Beat cream cheese in medium bowl with mixer until creamy. Blend in melted chocolate. Refrigerate 1 hour or until firm.

Cover baking sheet with waxed paper. Shape chocolate mixture into 36 balls, using about 2 tsp for each. Place in single lay on prepared baking sheet.

Melt remaining chocolate. Use toothpicks to dip truffles in chocolate; return to tray. Decorate as desired. Refrigerate 1 hour or until chocolate is firm. Enjoy!

Helpful Tips

What NOT to do with your Denture, if you use denture adhesive...

Do not over apply the product! If you do, you will have one big sticky mess that is difficult to clean. If you have a complete denture, apply three dots, one in the middle and one on each side. Press your denture into place, hold firmly and bite down for a few seconds to secure. By applying only dots onto the denture, it will spread within and there will not be an overflow. For partial dentures apply only two dots on either side of the denture to avoid an overflow of the product.
