THE IMPORTANCE OF AN ANNUAL EXAM

Your dentures are important to the way you look and feel. That's why it's important to maintain your dentures and ensure that they perform at their optimum. A regular check-up with your Denturist is the most effective way for you and your dentures to get the care and attention that you both deserve.

Over time, your mouth goes through considerable changes. Tissue shrinkage and loss of underlying bone (resorption) on which your dentures rest, will occur. Since your dentures do not change, they may no longer fit like they once did. This is what you can expect during your visit.

- update your dental and medical history
- intra-oral examination
- check the integrity of your denture
- check the esthetics, stability and the bite
- discuss options available to you based on your needs
- review of oral hygiene procedures and denture care
- · cleaning and polishing of your dentures

An oral exam will help detect oral cancer or other abnormal conditions using the Velscope Intraoral Scanner. Wom out dentures can cause an improper fit and bite which can also can affect your ability to speak and chew, as well as your appearance. We will also check for cracks, chips, scratches and worn or loose teeth. Call to book your appointment today, if your last visit was more than one year ago.

RECIPE

HOMEMADE BARBECUE SAUCE



1 1/2 cups Ketchup 1/2 cup packed Dark Brown Sugar 1 1/2 tsp Paprika 3 tbsp Cider Vinegar 1 1/2 tbsp. Worcestershire 3 medium Garlic Cloves finely chopped 3/4 tsp freshly Ground Black Pepper 1/4 tsp Celery Salt 1/2 cup Water

Combine all ingredients in a small saucepan over medium heat. Bring to a boil, stirring until all ingredients are combined. Reduce heat to low and gently simmer until sauce has thickened. Will take approximately 30-40 minutes. Remove from heat and let cool to room temperature. If not using right away, cover and refrigerate. Will stay fresh for up to two weeks. This homemade barbecue sauce is fabulous on everything! Enjoy!
