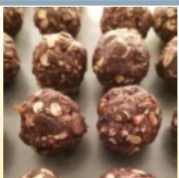
CUSTOM MADE DENTURES FOR YOU!

Did you know that no two people have the same set of teeth? Your teeth are as unique as your fingerprints, so be proud of your teeth! Also, no two sets of dentures are the same. You will not be able to borrow your spouses dentures as each mouth is a different size! We take impressions, so that we can have an exact fit of your mouth.

Quite often I will have patients tell me that they want their dentures to look like either Tom Cruise's or Julia Roberts teeth or that they want their teeth to be super white. This always makes me smile! We can definitely do that, but I highly recommend to all of my patients that they be proud of who they are! Having the whitest teeth possible seems glamorous, but what people don't realize is that it also draws attention to their teeth and the older you get, your teeth aren't naturally as bright as they once were. The best look will be the one that looks most natural. Take your age and skin tone into consideration. The general rule of thumb is that your teeth should not be whiter than the whites of your eyes.

I encourage patients to bring in pictures of their teeth when they liked them best. Patients have brought us pictures of their wedding, graduation and when they were younger. We then design the denture to look the way they want it. For instance, we have had requests to put a space between their two front teeth, tilt a tooth a particular way and even add a gold tooth to their denture. Patients are amazed at how natural looking their dentures are and are overjoyed to have their smile back and feel like themselves again! We get many hugs and often see tears of joy from our patients!

NO BAKE POWER BITES



1/2 c almond butter	1 cup unsweetened coconut
1/3 c honey	1/2 c chocolate chips
1 tsp vanilla extract	1/2 c cocoa nibs
1 c rolled oats	sea salt to taste

Mix almond butter, honey & vanilla extract together in a bowl until smooth. Stir oats, coconut, chocolate chips, cocoa nibs & sea salt into almond butter mixture until well combined; refrigerate for 30 minutes. Roll mixture into balls. Enjoy!
